program. Jamgara school is one of them. Total 17 students from Jamgara school of HOPE participated in the program. There were three science projects from the Jamgara School of HOPE. The projects were; 1) Homemade Mini Rocket Engine, 2) Web Development (Class Room Blog) and 3) Web Development (Online Shop). From 17 students 9 students participated in Science General Knowledge Competition. From the science projects, 'Mini Rocket Engine' group selected as a winner group. The name of the winners are; Oliul Islam Shanto (Class six), Md. Nayeem Hossain (Class Six) and Md. Ashraful Mia (Class seven). In December 2015, they will compete in the national level.

Students of class five are preparing for Primary School Certificate exam. 3rd round Class Test was started on 23 August and finished on 27 August. 135 students took part in the exam, out of them there were 66 boys and 69 girls.
