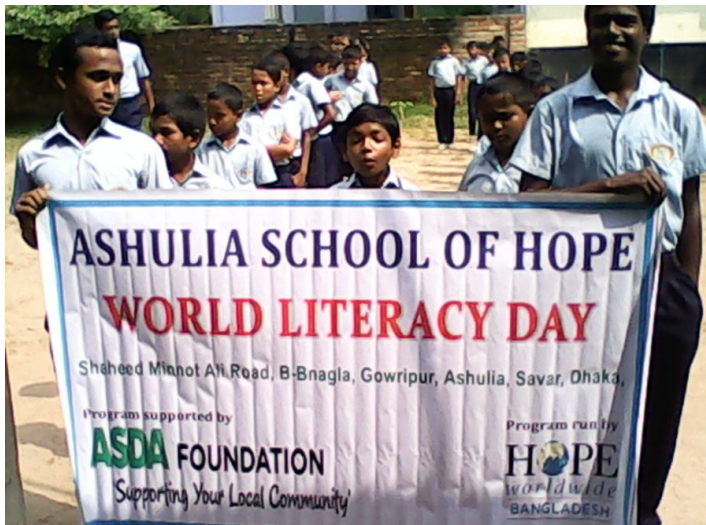
This will give the students a legal base for Child Protection against child abuse issues.

### INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY
