### SCIENCE CLUB SEMINAR

They had well wishes to all, they danced with students and distributed chocolate and fruits to them. After that teachers had a carol and patriotic song presentation. Students enjoyed the program very much with joy. Then we had the program on result distribution, on different category like good behavior, neat and clean, good hand writing, 100% attendance, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> class wise. We also selected Akhi Rani Das of class five as the 'student of the year' based on teachers recommendations. After prize distribution teachers distributed the result card to all the students in the classes. Among 230 students, 213 students were promoted to next class.

## PSC & JSC RESULT

On 31<sup>st</sup> December, we received the Government Primary School Certification Exam result (PSC - standard 5) and Junior School Certification Exam Result (JSC – Standard 8).

In PSC, total 20 students sat for the exam. We have continued our result of 100% pass this year also. Among them, the 1<sup>st</sup> girl of class five Akhi Rani Das got Golden A+ (GPA 5.0, the highest grade) who is already the student of the year. 13 students got A and 6 students got A -. In JSC, total 12 students sat for the exam. We have continued our result of 100% pass this year also. Among them, 3 students got A, 8 students got A – and 1 student got B grade.

Her father sells fish and her mother works in a garments factory. Their family income is about 15,000/= Taka (USD 192) per month. Their house rent is 4000/= (USD 51) Taka per month. Rojina came to know about the HOPE School from a neighboring student who is studying in HOPE School. After

communicating with the authority, she got the opportunity to study here. She is serious to study hard with her lessons. She tries to participate in all activities as per curriculum. Previously she was very weak in Math but after getting admission in HOPE School the weakness is reduced and improved by the help of her hard work and the support of her teachers. She is a good football player also.

She gets uniform, shoes, bag, study materials and midday meal regularly. Her future goal is to be a football player.
