### **WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY**

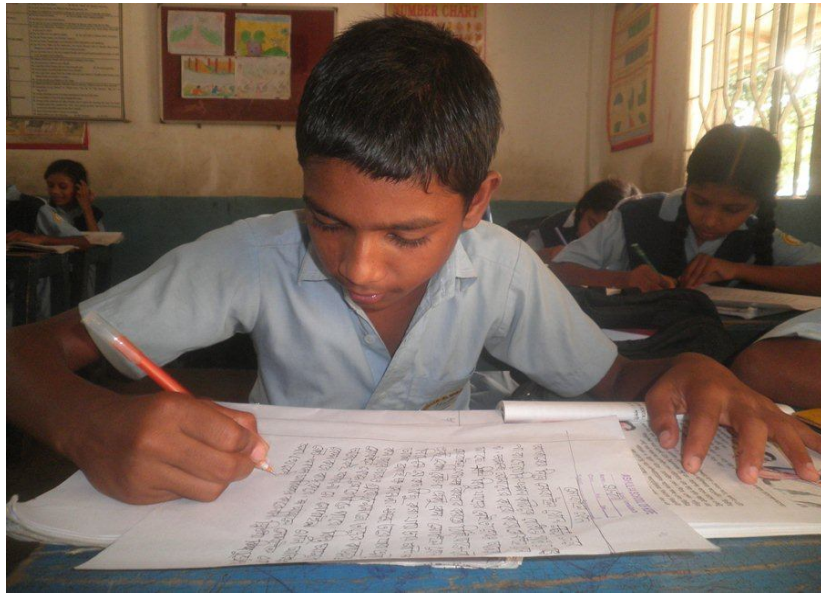

## Story of Shumi Khatun

Shumi Khatun is a student of class 4. She is 12 years old. Her father's name is Sultan Mahamud and mother's name is Aleya Khatun. Her family came to Ashulia from the village



of the district of Pabna about three years ago for searching job or better income. At the same time they were searching a better school for their daughter. Shumi came to know about HOPE School from her neighbors. After communication with the authority she got the opportunity to get admission and began to study here.

Their family consists of five members. Her elder sister is married and lives with her husband. Her younger brother is very small. Her younger sister reads in this school in class one.

Her father and mother both work in a garment factory. Their monthly family income is about Tk. 10,600/= (USD 136) only. She is very serious about her studies. She tries to participate in all activities as per curriculum.

She gets uniform, shoes, bag, study materials and midday meal from the school. Previously, she was very weak in Math but after getting admission in HOPE School the weakness has been reduced and improved with the help of her hard work and the support of her teachers. She wants to be a doctor.
