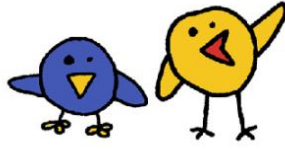

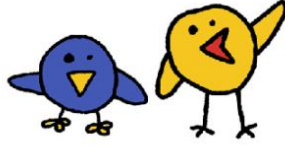

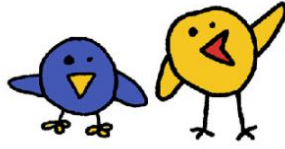
Victory Day Celebration

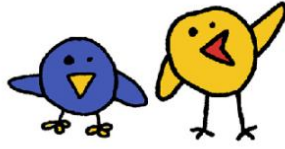


Drawing Competition

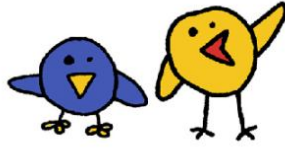




Annual Exam Result & Prize Distribution

Mamun's family came to Aichnowdda from the village in the district of Mymansingh. Mamun is studying in class LKG. At present, he is 6 years old. His father's name is Babul and mother's name is Fulmala. The family consists of four members. Mamun has one brother.

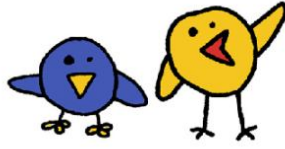
His father is a caretaker and mother is a housewife.

He gets uniform, shoes, bags, study materials and midday meal regularly. Previously he was very weak in all subjects but after getting admission in Soham for All School of HOPE the weakness in reduced and improved by the help of his hard work and support of his teacher.

He wants to be a police officer in future.

Story of Alomgir Jammaddar (U.K.G.)





Alomgir Jammaddar is a student of UKG in Soham for All School of HOPE. His father's name is Rafiq Jammaddar and mother's name is Salma. He is eight years old. Alomgir has two brothers- Sahjalal and Rajib. Sahjalal is eleven years old and Rajib is six months. He lives with his father, mother and brothers in a small room at Aichanoyadda, Savar. Sahjalal reads in class 3 of BRAC School at Savar. He works in a grocery shop as a sales boy and earns 800 (USD 10) Taka only in every month. His father is a disable person. He cannot work and earn money. Every month he gets 500 Taka (USD 6.4) from the government as a disable fund. His mother is a housewife. She cannot work outside because she has to take care of her little child Rajib. Actually their total income is 1300 Taka (USD 16.4) only but his father begs on the roads, shops and buses at savar and earns some to survive. The expense of whole month of Alomgir's family is always due. Every month they need to pay the due bills of grocery shops, daily bazars, to the doctors and payment of their educational expenses. Moreover every month his family needs to pay 2000 Taka (USD 25.6) as a house rent. Therefore, they need to live theirs daily life with suffering. Alomgir stay in school from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm. He is very regular in the class. He is always active and also gentle in the class. If he gets time, he likes to draw and color pictures. His favorite color is pink. He likes to eat rice and fish fry. In his free time he likes to play games. His favorite game is football. He is very aggressive to participate in the school programs. He wants to be a doctor in future.

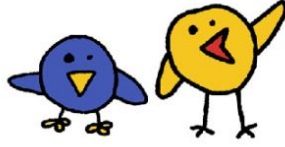
