Her mother and one elder brother work in garments factory and her father is a rickshaw driver. Their family income is about 16000 Taka (USD 200) per month. Shumi came to know about HOPE School from her cousin. Now is very serious about her studies. She tries to participate in all activities as per curriculum.

Sumi gets gets uniform, shoes, bag, study materials and midday meal regularly from the school. Previously she was very weak in mathematics but day by day the weakness is reduced for her hard work and with the support her teachers. She wants to be a doctor in the future.
