## JAMGARA SCHOOL OF HOPE (GEORGE SCHOOL)

### WORLD HEALTH DAY



On 7<sup>th</sup> April Jamgara School of HOPE observed World Health Day. All the students attended the program. All the teachers, Head Teacher and Coordinator were also present in the program. The program began at 1.00 pm by the greetings of the Coordinator. Then the Head Teacher gave some important speech about

health and nutrition. All the students heard his speech carefully. Two dramas were presented on the stage about health and nutrition. In the middle of the program, one of the teachers presented the students how to wash hands. Then we had a cartoon show on the projector about the health and fitness. We distributed tooth brush and toothpaste among the students.

### BENGALI NEW YEAR CELEBRATION

“Pahela Baishakh” is the first day of the Bengali New year. We celebrated the day on 13<sup>th</sup> April. The students arranged “Baishakhi Mela (fair)” on the school premises. All the students, teachers and honorable guests were present in the program. The program began at 11:00 am with the traditional song “Esho he



Baishakh” sang by the students. The students painted colorful pattern (Alpana) on their face. At 12.00 pm we took a break for special Bengali food. From 1.00 pm to 3.00 pm we



restarted our program with various kinds of cultural functions (dance, song, acting and recitation). Then an indoor cricket (short pitch) tournament took place on the school compound.

### IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM

On 24<sup>th</sup> April, Jamgara School arranged 2<sup>nd</sup> dose vaccination. Total 191 students and staffs took the vaccine under this program. Next dose of vaccine will be given on 22<sup>nd</sup> May.

## BENGALI NEW YEAR CELEBRATION

On 13<sup>th</sup> April "Pohela Boisakh" was observed in the Ashulia School of HOPE. Students drew colourful patterns (alpana) on their face. Then they sat in the hall room. 53 boys and 56 girls were present on that day. Then they learned the meaning of Pohela Boisakh and why and how we



observe it. The program begun with a group song. The students also did solo song, group

dance, solo dance, recitation, drama and fashion show. Then they took lunch with traditional food and also ate water melon.

2<sup>nd</sup> Class Test begun on 20 April and finished on 28 April. Total 142 students attended the exam. Now they are preparing for their Half Yearly Exam.
