Among all students, one student is Hepatitis B positive but is on nonreactive stage. For her, we are taking proper advice from doctor now.

Mim Akter is a student of class one. She is 8 years old. Her family came from Pobakhali village of the District of Pabna 4 years ago for better earning.

Mim got admitted in class K G. Her father's name is Md. Akram and mother's name is Sukriya Begum. The family consists of 5 members. Her one younger sister is 6 years old and one elder brother is studying here in class 4.

Her mother works in a garments factory. Her father is a rickshaw puller. Their family income is about TK 18,000 (USD 230) per month. Mim Akter came to know about HOPE from her neighbor. She is serious about her studies. She tries to participate in all activities as per curriculum.

Mim Akter gets uniform, shoes, bag, study materials and mid-day meal regularly. She wants to be a doctor in future.
