She was looking for an opportunity to learn a good and quality tailoring course. From her neighbor, she came to know about the tailoring course of the HOPE Vocational Training Center. She learnt to make different type of dresses for children, men and women.

At the time of admission she did not have any idea about sewing. But after finishing the course, she became skilled. She is now confident to make different types of dresses. Now she make dress for her family and neighbors. That adds some extra income and benefit to her family. She is thankful to HOPE for providing this type of training.
