Jakia Akther is a house wife with two children. Her husband works in a garments factory. He earns BDT. 10,000 (USD 128) per month for the family which is not enough.



She came to know about HOPE from the school children. So, she came and got admitted in Sewing section. After that she admitted again in Small and Medium Entrepreneurship section to learn various handicrafts items.

While she was learning the courses, she started to sell the products of bag and Jewelry items. She already sold and made 10,000 Taka (USD 128) profits. She spend that additional income for the family and for the treatment of her father. Now she earns 5,000 Taka (USD 64) per month regularly. She is now able to fulfill her children's small wishes too. As a result, her family status has been improved and they are very happy now. Now she is getting more and more work order. Her dream is to establish a shop in future. She is grateful to HOPE for providing this kind of training.
