Imrul Kayes was a student of Industrial Center of HOPE Ahulia. He has just completed his Higher Secondary School certification this year. His father is a garments worker and only

earning member of the family. Mother is housewife. Their family earning was \$150 to \$180 per month. They are three brothers and sisters and they live hand to mouth. As the elder son of the family, he felt sad that they were in financial crisis to continue their education.



That is why he thought to do something for his family besides his education. Then he came to know about HOPE Computer and English Learning Center from one of his friends. He learnt the basic computing on September 2015. After completing the course successfully again he

admitted for Graphic design course on November 2015 and completed the course by February 2016. Then he took computer freelance outsourcing work as a profession. He started working on Upwork and Fiverr outsourcing agency. Now he earns \$8 per day or about \$240 per month. Now he can earn enough money for his family and they became solvent.

Now he is happy and grateful to HOPE for providing such a training, support and counselling in a minimum cost so that it is affordable for them who are needy like him. Like him many other's life is changing and become self-employed and solvent.
