Her younger sister is only 3 years old. Her mother is a house wife. Her father works in a garments factory. Their family income is about TK 12000 (USD 154) per month. Maria Sultana does his household activities regularly. She also looks after her younger sister.

Maria Sultana comes to know about HOPE from her neighbor. Then she communicates to the authority of HOPE. She got the opportunity of admission and running her study here. She is serious about her studies. She tries to participate in all activities as per curriculum.

Maria Sultana gets uniform, shoes, bag, study materials and mid-day meal regularly. From the school. She wants to be a police officer so that she can serve the people and protect their rights. She also wants to remove crime from the society.
