## Success Story of Shahnaz Begum

### BACKGROUND

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Shahnaz Begum is a house wife. She has three daughters and one son. Her four children study in HOPE school. Her husband works in a garments factory. He was the only earning member of the family and earns 14000 Taka (USD 179) per month. This was not enough to run their family of six members.

### IN INDUSTRIAL CENTER OF HOPE, ASHULIA

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She came to know about the vocational trades in Industrial Center of HOPE- Ashulia. She got admitted in Small and Medium Entrepreneurship program to learn 19 handicrafts items.

## **DEVELOPMENTS**

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As a process of learning, she learnt to make jewelry item and different types of bags. Last month, she earned 3000 Taka (USD 38.46) by selling jewelry item and different types of bags. She is now getting more and more orders. With that money she purchased dress for her children on the occasion of Eid. Now she makes bags and jewelry item every day at home and her husband sells the products on weekly holiday. Thus she makes some additional income for the family. With that income, now she can solve small financial problems of the family.

## **CONCLUSION**

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She and her husband is very happy and grateful to HOPE for providing this opportunity. Now she is learning other items of handicrafts and sewing course also.
