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Story of Sajahan (Class one)



Md. Sajahan is a student of class one in Soham for All School of HOPE. His father's name is Rafiq and mother's name is Sapla. He is eight years old. Sajahan has one younger brother Safiul. Safiul is four years old. He lives with his father, mother and brother in a small room at Aichanoyadda, Savar. Safiul reads in class L.K.G in the same school. His father works in a hotel as cook. He does not earn much money. His mother is a housewife. She cannot work outside because she has to take care of her little child. She earns a little by doing tailoring work at her home and support her family. Their total monthly income is 8000 Taka (USD 102) only. Every month his family needs to pay 2500 Taka (USD 32) as a house rent. Sajahan stays in school from 11:40 am to 04:20 pm. He is very regular in the class. He is always active and also gentle in the class. If he gets time, he likes to watch cartoon. His favorite color is purple and orange. He likes to eat egg and fish. His favorite fruit is mango. In his free time he likes to play games. Sajahan wants to be a doctor.

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Story of Sapla Begum (Tailoring)

Sapla Begum is a house wife and she is a mother of two kids- Sahajahan and Safiul. Her husband is a cook. Her both sons study in Soham for All School. This year she completed her 3 months tailoring course successfully. Sapla bought one old machine and now she has started to take order for making dress from her neighbors. She earns 2000 TK (USD 26) per month. She and her family is very happy about her success that as a house wife she can support the family. Now she is learning indrustrial sewing to do better. She is very thankful and grateful to Soham for All Center of HOPE.
