Story of Sadia Akter Khadija (Class One)

Sadia Akter Khadija is a student of class one in Soham for All School of HOPE. She is 6 years old. Her father's name is Hakim Sarder, mother's name is Mayina Akter. They are 2 sisters & 1 brother. Her brother is 2 years old. Her father is a daily labour and mother is house wife. Her elder sister Happy

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works in a garments factory. Their family income is Tk 15000 (USD 188) per month. When Sadia's mother heard about this school, she immediately took the opportunity and came to admit her child. Sadia is very gentle and attentive student in the class. Her favorite colour is blue, favorite fruit is apple. She loves to eat fish and egg. Sadia loves to play cricket. She wants to become a doctor in future.

Story of Mst. Bulbuli (Sewing)



This is Mst. Bulbuli. She is 19 years old. She lives in Aichanowadda, Savar. She is from a village named Chakarpara, Hakimpur, Dinajpur. In Dinajpur she studied in a High School till standard seven. Before joining this program, she used to help her family in household work. When staffs of Soham sewing

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section went for survey, her mother first came to know about HOPE and joined in Sewing Operator training. By the inspiration of her mother, she also admitted in Industrial Sewing Operator training program here. After doing the course, she is performing better in the her job place. Now she works in a garments factory as a Machine Operator. She draws BDT 6000 (USD 75) per month. Md. Bulbul Ahmed, her father is a daily laborer. Her mother Mst. Rupsana Begum also works in a garments factory as a Machine Operator. Her younger sister studies in LKG at Soham for All School section. Slowly she is touching her dream by changing her own life. Now she supports her family financially. Their family has become more solvent than before. They are so very grateful to HOPE and the donors for the support they got. They are looking for a bright future ahead.

Computer & Spoken English Section:
