His Mother is a housewife. He has one younger sister and brother. His father earns 7000 Tk (USD 88.6) in a month. His younger sister Nandani studies in this school too. Anik Robi Das is a good student. His hobby is drawing & reading books. His favorite color is pink and yellow, his favorite flower is water lily, rose. He likes to have meat, fish, jackfruit, banana and litchi. He likes to play cricket. He loves to come to school because of many activities. His dream is to be a Police.

Success Story of Ratna Akter Nazma (Sewing)

This is Ratna Akter Nazma. She is 25 years old and lives in Aichanowadda, Savar. Before joining this program, she worked in a garments factory as Helper. She studied in her native village till eight grade. Sagor, her husband is a garments worker and Sadia her only daughter of 3 years old. Ratna came to know about Sewing Operator Training from the students studying in our primary school. After getting
